

New Football Officials Class

2018 Dates: Wednesdays June 6 through July 18

The Indiana Officials Association (IOA) offers this program for individuals interested in officiating youth and high school football. Experienced officials will guide you through your first year as an official – from obtaining your license to working games at an appropriate level.

- Step 1: REGISTRATION This course is open to all applicants who have submitted the registration and fee by June 6, 2018. Complete and mail the registration form below with payment to secure your place in the class; or bring it with you the first night. The fee includes IOA membership, materials, and instruction. You must also join the Indiana High School Athletic Association www.ihsaa.org and pay the licensing fee. The IHSAA membership includes an official license (after passing a test) and materials to include rule books. You will need to do this before the first class. REGISTER NOW!
- Step 2: Rules and Mechanics Study on Wednesdays, between 6:00 PM and 9:00 PM. There will be 6 classes on the following dates: June 6, 13, 20, 27, and July 11, 18. All classes will be held at Lawrence North High School, 7802 Hague Road, Indianapolis, IN 46256. The class will convene in the Athletic LGI. (Enter Door #11 at the back of the school)
- **Step 3: IHSAA Licensure Exam** during the testing period. Tests are on-line. We will discuss this process during class.
- **Step 4: Mechanics Study** on Wednesdays during class on dates above. **Practical Clinic** with on field experience at a local high school
- **Step 5: Association Meetings** on most Wednesdays in July, August, and September with presentations and video for all IOA football officials.
- Step 6: Expectations of Officials: Please read the second page of this document.

- 7. Work as many games as you can possibly work during the season. There is no better teacher than game experience, no matter the level of the game.
